Over the past several years, JFS has navigated exciting yet complex cultural, societal, and community issues, with real-life consequences for our clients, staff, and greater community here in the Puget Sound region.

Yet JFS stepped up, in partnership with you, to respond to:

- Political and civil unrest
- Rising antisemitism
- The pandemic and associated shifts in the needs of our clients and community
- Dramatic growth and swings in demand for refugee and immigrant support, with refugee crises in Afghanistan and Ukraine, and changes in the type and amount of government funding available

We knew it was time to move into our future in a proactive and strategic way.



OUR IMPACT

We will grow our impact and hold ourselves accountable to the communities we serve.

JFS positively impacts the Puget Sound region's Jewish community, refugees and immigrants, and the broader community with life-changing programs and services that are sustainable and culturally sensitive.

Last year, we provided \$802,000 in financial assistance to our community to help prevent eviction and **stave off financial crises;** more than 2,000 of our neighbors were able to **access healthy food** through our food bank; we enabled 196 **Holocaust survivors** to live with dignity; and we helped 1,600 **refugees, immigrants, and survivors of human trafficking** make new lives here.

WHAT WE'LL DO:

- Increase targeted outreach to our local congregations and Jewish agencies to prevent domestic violence and support survivors of intimate partner violence.
- Explore innovative approaches to support our programs for refugees, immigrants, and survivors of trafficking, as well as unaccompanied minors.
- Launch a day program for Russian-speaking older adults, collaborating with local senior centers, to increase support and in-person connection.

OUR JEWISH

We will harness the power of Jewish community and define "Jewish community" inclusively.

JFS brings people together to support each other in times of need, and we have many **volunteer opportunities** where you can live out your values. **Everyone needs support,** and everyone can provide support. **We are each other's keepers.**

WHAT WE'LL DO:

- Launch Elder Connections, an opportunity to put your Jewish values into action by supporting and connecting with our elders in the community.
- Invest in assessing the needs of the Jewish community, in partnership with Jewish community organizations, to learn more about our community's evolving needs and to determine the most effective ways to enhance our programs and services in response to those needs.
- Expand our Jewish Community Connections program to connect with and build strong relationships within our diverse Jewish community and nurture the next generation of Jewish leaders through increased community education events and volunteer opportunities.

OUR JFS

By **investing in our people, processes, and culture,** modernizing our infrastructure, and strengthening our operational effectiveness, JFS is growing to meet our community's **changing needs.** We are **investing in the systems and staff** we need to support that growth with staff, volunteers, and supporters who are strong, empowered, and **dedicated to our mission.**

- Provide learning opportunities for all JFS staff, with a focus on deepening internal relationships and increasing our culture of belonging.

 NEW! Refine our program analysis tools to better measure and evaluate the outcomes of the services we provide.
